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QUESTIONS FOR PARENTS

As a family, take the time to read Philippians 4:2-7. Then use the following questions for discussion:

- God created each one of us; moms, dads, brothers, and sisters. We make up a family! When I think of the word family, I think of togetherness. Discuss what togetherness means. Paul explains that believers are in a partnership in sharing the gospel, and sometimes there is disagreement. Paul tells us that we need to strive for unity. Talk about what unity means. It is important for families to have unity, just as God had unity through the trinity!
- Paul goes on and tells us that we need to have an attitude of rejoicing. What are some things that you find yourself rejoicing about? Paul also tells us that we need to not have an attitude of anxiety, or worrying. What are some things that you find yourself worrying about?
- Let us gather together as we partnership in sharing the gospel, and may our praises outweigh our worries!

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
