When it comes to living God's Truth, we believe it's best to know it by heart. That's why we're excited to continue helping kids memorize Scripture and biblical truths that fit with the lessons from our curriculum: *Lost & Found*.

HOW IT WORKS To encourage the kids to get involved, we're rewarding memorization success and other commendable Christ-like actions with award stickers each week.

Students can earn stickers the following ways:

- Memorizing one verse every week
- Memorizing the Big Idea Truth from the previous lesson
- **NEW!** Memorizing the One Another statements
- Attending and showing self-control each week
- Bringing a friend

THE GOAL Over the 16-week semester, we've challenged the students to work toward the following goals:

- **PreK-1st Grade:** Earn 20 stickers
- **2nd-4th Grade:** Earn 30 stickers

THE REWARDS In May, we'll honor diligent students who've reached their goal with an award celebration and treats.
